The City of Orlando recently replaced an old inlet and catchbasin along Weber St. with a Nutrient Separating Baffle Box model NSBB-4-8-72. Although this stormwater treatment structure is relatively small in size, with an inside dimension measuring only 4' wide x 8' long, 72" tall, **water treatment is big.**

Nutrient Separating Baffle Boxes can be sized to fit pipes that range in size from 12" to 72". Smaller structures like the one installed along Weber St offer **maximum water treatment at minimal expense.**

***System Is Resistant  
To Bacterial Growth***

The internal screen system separates foliage and litter from static water below so that it doesn't get a chance to become a food source for bacterial growth.

The Nutrient Separating Baffle Box arrives to the job site with all the interior components pre-installed at the concrete casting facility. **Setting the structure is as easy as stacking the top half onto the bottom half.**
